Mon, Feb 3rd at 4 PM

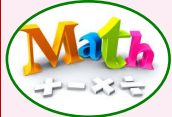
About to turn 65 or older? Understanding Medicare and your options can be confusing. Join Jennifer Rollins as she outlines Medicare and all your options.
